Sunday, May 20 - Shavuot Morning Scholar-in-Residence Rabbi Mark Trencher - "10 Surprising Findings About Modern Orthodoxy"

Mark Trencher of Nishma Research will share insights, many of them surprising, gleaned from two major studies done in the Jewish community. These will include reasons given by those who left observance, beliefs and attitudes in the community, how people see and value their Judaism as a part of their life, directions people and their children are taking (becoming more or less observant ... is the community fragmenting?), how people relate to their shuls and Jewish study, views toward women's communal roles within Orthodoxy (including shul positions and those within the clergy), and opportunities and challenges facing the community.
