We realize, however, that small children may need a snack to remain in the sanctuary and chapel. We ask parents to do so discreetly. This request is based on *Shulchan Aruch* (Code of Jewish Law) guidelines for maintaining the sanctity of a sanctuary.

As an experiment in accommodation, cold water with cups will be set on a table in the social hall for Shabbat Tefilah morning attendees as needed.
