As the outdoor temperatures warm, we are all more cognizant about staying hydrated. Nonetheless, we ask our worshippers to be respectful of sanctuary protocol. **Please keep food and beverages out of the sanctuary or chapel.** Use other public areas of the building for water or snacks. We realize, however, that small children may need a snack to remain in the sanctuary and chapel. We ask parents to do so discreetly. This request is based on *Shulchan Aruch* (Code of Jewish Law) guidelines for maintaining the sanctity of a sanctuary. As an accommodation, cold water with cups are set on a table in the social hall for Shabbat Tefilah morning attendees as needed.
