RE: Right-of-Entry

Now that FEMA has officially designated Hurricane Nate a declared disaster, Town contractors are in the process of mobilizing equipment and man power to begin the removal of sand from rights-of-way and returning it to the south shoreline. Current plans call for all materials to be screened and deposited equitably along the Gulf-fronting beach areas. Due to limited access in some of the heavily eroded portions of the shoreline and to expedite the recovery process, the Town of Dauphin Island is respectfully requesting a right-of-entry from each property owner south of Bienville Blvd. from Ponce de Leon Court to the west end of Bienville Blvd. A Right-of-Entry form is attached for your review and signature. RIGHT-OF-ENTRY FOR PLACEMENT OF SAND

The undersigned, hereinafter called the Owner, hereby grants to THE TOWN OF DAUPHIN ISLAND and its assigns, hereinafter the Town, a permit or right-of-entry upon the following terms and conditions:

1. The Owner hereby grants to the Town and its assigns as irrevocable right to enter upon the lands hereinafter described at any time within a period of six (6) months from the date of this instrument, in order to perform construction work of any nature in connection with the placement of sand on the beach on Dauphin Island.
2. This permit includes the right of ingress and egress on other lands of the Owner not described below, provided that such ingress and egress is necessary and not otherwise conveniently available to the Town.
3. All tools, equipment, buildings, improvements, and other property taken upon or placed on the land by the Town, its contractors or assigns shall remain the property of the Town, its contractors or assigns and may be removed by the Town, its contractors or assigns at any time within a reasonable period after the expiration of this permit or right-of-entry.
4. The Town or its assigns shall have the right to patrol and police the lands hereinafter described during the period of this permit or right-of-entry.
