

Artisan Knitworks Classes and Workshops

Helping knitters and crocheters become better is our mission. We believe that the better you are, the more you will enjoy the fiber arts regardless of age or gender. It's that simple.



Knit-Togethers are our several-times-a-week that combine learning, problem solving and social knitting and crochet.

There is no charge. However, do have to charge \$5 for help that requires more than a quick look. (Naturally, more intense help will require more time and cost a bit more.) You need to use Artisan Knitworks yarn for new projects.

Our current Knit-Together schedule: Tuesdays from 11:30 to 1:30; Thursdays from 3:30 to 5:30. Fridays from 2:00 to 4:00. Saturday and Sunday from about 1:30 to closing. Additions and changes to the Knit-Together schedule will be posted on Facebook and shared via our newsletter, Purl Daily.

Sweaters with Sandra: Saturday, 11:00am-1:00pm (bring your lunch!). This knit and crochet group is about making sweaters that fit well and are finished professionally. Pick your own project. We also will talk about how to design simple sweaters without a pattern or alter existing patterns.



Just Getting Started Knit-Togethers (\$10 per session)

Beginning Knitting and Crochet: Join Sandra on Mondays from 4:00 to 6:00. Yes, this is a mixed group. Learn the basics of knitting while discovering how cool crochet can be. And it works the other way, too. The point is that of these two fiber crafts truly reinforce each other.

Beginning Knitting: Arlene will get started on your way to becoming an accomplished knitter each Wednesday from noon to 2:00. (You can "Brown Bag" it if you'd like!)

At least 2 sessions (knit and crochet) are needed, but you are of course welcome to attend as many sessions as you want.

Tutorials/Private Lessons...

If you can't attend a Knit-Together, we offer tutorials at \$20 per lesson (two 1-hour sessions). We also teach kids. One-on-one knitting and crochet instruction for children (generally over age 7, with good fine motor skills, a genuine interest). Parents should consider learning with children! Children generally learn better in short classes. So, we recommend that most sessions be an hour (\$10 / hour per person).

Open Knitting:

We welcome all knitters, crocheters, and other artisans who want to sit and work on their projects whenever we do not have a scheduled event. We ask that you use our materials for future projects.

We hope that visitors will honor our staff (and the need to pay rent) with five-dollar contributions whenever help requires sitting down and spending time

Knit-Crochet with Lynne, with special attention to Socks & Other Small

On the third Sunday of each month (October. 22), Lynne Wardrop will travel all the way from Harper Woods for this class. Lynne is one of the best sock mavens and designers around – no kidding. The class runs from 1:00pm-4:00pm. Crocheters and Knitters are encouraged to attend. \$20 per session. And, you get 10% off all full priced yarn during the session.



Topical Workshops:

Sandra teaches all workshops unless otherwise noted. We ask that, for all classes (except stash-busters), all yarn must be purchased from Artisan Knitworks. Single session workshops are \$25 two-session ones are \$40, and three-session ones are \$55. Preregistration is required for all topical workshops.

As we get settled in, the topical workshop list still a bit in the air. (Can't do everything at once. Although, we do try!) We welcome class suggestions and will consider opening one when we receive three or more requests for the same class
