

Artisan Knitworks Classes and Workshops Are Serious Bargains

Helping knitters and crocheters become better at their craft is the basic mission of Artisan Knitworks. Simply put: we believe that the better you are, the more you will enjoy the fiber arts regardless of one's age or gender. It's that simple and it's why we encourage "starting them young."

We offer one-on-one knitting and crochet instruction for children (over age 7, with good fine motor skills, a genuine interest, and sufficient attention span) and adults, by advance appointment. Parents should consider learning with children! Because of the attention spans of most children we recommend that most sessions be limited to about an hour or so. \$10.00/hour per person.



There has also been a shift in the evening Knit-Togethers. The two weekly events are on Wednesday (Sharon) and Thursday (Sandra). If you don't need help, it's free. If you do, it's \$5.

As you perhaps know, shops incur expenses, like any other small business. So, we are always glad to receive some minor financial help.

Here are the details.

- No charge if you don't need help and just sit and knit or crochet. (Donations to the refreshment fund are always welcome.).
- Minor help – e.g., putting stitches back on your needles, fixing minor problems, telling you minor points, \$5.
- Teaching or help that requires for more than a few minutes, short of a full-blown lesson is \$10.
- Private tutoring is also available.

Learn to Knit with Sharon McKenna Wednesday, 2:00-3:00



Four introductory sessions include: (1) Casting on and knitting; (2) Purling and binding off; (3) Basic shaping; and (4) basic pattern stitches. \$10 per session each person.

This activity is in addition to her Wednesday evening Knit-Together which starts about 6:30 and runs until 8:30 or so.

Knit-Together with Sandra... Thursday Evening 6:30 – 8:30

Thursday evenings are the time to enjoy good conversation and develop your fiber skills. Knitters and crocheters of all skill levels are welcome to join.

Sweater Saturdays With Sandra...

A number of customers have asked us to start a loosely organized group dedicated to making a sweater - in some cases, the very first sweater - and making sure that it fits!



Saturdays from 11:00 to 1:30 or so, Sandra leads a new drop-in, knit-along group devoted to knitted (or crocheted) sweaters. The cost will be \$10 for each session that you choose to attend. And, you can join at any time!

You can buy a coupon (good for 6 sessions) for \$55.00, redeemable over ten weeks. Or you can pay \$10 each time. Buy yarn in advance (Sandra is in-house on Friday through Sunday to help you). Decide if you want to use a published pattern (which we can modify within limits) or have Sandra create a pattern.

Please use our yarn - we need to stay in business!!!! This can be a brown-bag, by the way - we'll provide coffee/tea.
