

More information on how immigrants effect our US economy and life:

- Currently, there are more undocumented immigrants leaving USA than entering our country.
- And there are fields in California with tomatoes and avocado rotting now due to lack of migrant workers.
- There are still millions of undocumented immigrants who are currently working for big farms around the US without any criminal offense, because most American citizens do not want to do the hard labor required for these jobs.
- Trump properties have hired 480 immigrants with H-2B temporary VISAS since June 2015 to work as cooks maids and servers.
- Since 2010 Mar-A-Lago has only hired 17 US residents.
- Last June 2017, Homeland security raised the caps of H-2B VISAS from 66,000 to 81,000 a year. Because hotels, ski resorts and landscape companies can't find enough American workers to do that kind of work.

- The union leaders say that's not true; instead company and corporations are hiring seasonal immigrant workers to save money on labor costs with lower wages, less benefits and no overtime.
- President Trump recently asked the department of labor for permission to hire 61 additional immigrant cooks and servers for Mar-A-Lago.
- Undocumented immigrants paid more than \$11.8 billion dollars in taxes in 2012.
- Undocumented immigrants pay sales and property tax, helping fund public schools and local government services.
- Undocumented immigrants pay more in taxes than the benefits they receive.
- Undocumented immigrants are not eligible to receive Medicare, Social Security, and food stamp. Yet, SS is deducted from their pay checks, but they can't access these benefits.
- Currently, there is more violence per-capita among us citizens than undocumented immigrants.

- Crime rates are lowest in states with the highest immigration growth.
