The Vision Nouvelle school's music program currently consists of over 100 violin students, studying by Suzuki method, from books 1-7, as well as some violists and cellists, over 50 piano students as well as some guitar and flute students. All students receive theory lessons as well as opportunities to participate in vocal choir and orchestra. The orchestra sometimes accompanies their parent-choir.

How are we changing lives in Haiti?
