


Eduardo Cazap – tuvuga Healthcare Group (THCG) Advisory Board Member

Dr. Eduardo Cazap MD, PhD is an Argentinian medical oncologist with a longstanding clinical and scientific career in Argentina and internationally. He is the founder and President of the Latin American & Caribbean Society of Medical Oncology (SLACOM). Dr. Cazap's dedication to equal access to quality cancer care and his relentless effort to advocate for cancer care in developing countries is unparalleled. Having published over 180 papers, his main areas of research and interest are global health, cancer control and prevention, breast and cervical cancer and independent clinical research. For the last 15 years, he is one of the beginners of the concept of "Global Cancer Control" and is an active key player in the international cancer scene. His vast knowledge in cancer and passion to find solutions for it has made him a regular plenary speaker, chair or moderator at global cancer and health meetings as well as part of organizing major international conferences.

Dr. Cazap's tireless efforts are finding traction among world oncology leaders. Additionally, he is working to develop a Global Cancer Plan and a Global Cancer Fund, similar to the HIV-AIDS Global Fund, to facilitate action on a larger scale. His notable current and past roles include being one of five members of the Executive Board of the national Cancer Institute of Argentina and is responsible for Cancer Prevention and International Affairs, Chairman of the Executive Committee of the Breast Health Global Initiative (BHGI), member of the Advisory Council of the European Cancer Organization (ECCO), co-chair of the Civil Society



Taskforce to advise the President of the United Nations General Assembly on the 2011 United Nations High-Level meeting on Non-communicable Diseases, founding member of the Ethnic Research Institute in Cancer (ERI) USA, President of the Argentinean Society of Clinical Oncology (AAOC), President of the General Assembly of the International Union against Cancer (UICC-Geneva) and many more.
