Located in Ravenswood, West Virginia, this one story emergency medical services building includes a total of 5,379 square feet. This new facility will serve as an office, living quarters for shift workers and maintenance areas for emergency medical equipment and emergency medical vehicles that serve the surrounding areas.

Wolf Creek Contracting Co., LLC served as the general contractor and construction manager for this project and utilized many local contractors in the area to complete this project.

The construction included full HVAC and electrical systems along with masonry veneer over block walls on masonry and concrete foundation, concrete floor slab-on-grade, wood roof and wall framing, shingle roof covering along with steel doors and frames throughout the facility.

Working closely with ZMM Architects out of Charleston, WV, and the Jackson County Commission, Wolf Creek Contractors oversaw the complete construction of the facility from the ground up. The project will now provide extended services to local residents and increase the response time to citizens in need of the County's emergency medical services.
