## Healthcare: \$10-\$25 Million

March-Westin Company was contracted by Mon General Hospital to complete the renovations & expansions on the existing hospital campus. This included renovation of an existing wing housing the radiation therapy and medical oncology suite as well as new construction of two radiation vaults. One houses a linear accelerator or LINAC, the other PET/CT equipment.

The multi-phased project also included a complete renovation of the existing surgical suite and construction of four

new OR rooms. This work was completed while the OR and surgical department remained fully operational.

## Safety and Design

On-site construction began in January of 2016. Construction at this site was challenging due to the fact that renovations were performed while the hospital remained fully operational. This was for March-Westin to adhere to elevated ICRA protocols.

The radiation vaults were constructed with 7' thick concrete walls and a 3' thick concrete ceiling. The surgical area construction took place on the 4<sup>th</sup> floor of the facility and required removing and reconfiguring structural walls while the adjacent operating rooms remained operational.

## Project Duration:

- One Year. Construction began in January of 2016 and was completed in July of 2017.

## Project Safety:

- March-Westin Company, Inc., a certified Accredited Quality Contractor (AQC), and ABC STEP Diamond recipient, recorded no safety related incidents during the project's duration.
- March-Westin Company, Inc. held weekly toolbox safety meetings.
