Jarrett Construction Services mobilized in March of 2016 to begin construction on this 14,500-sq. ft., two-story facility which will serve as Pioneer Federal Credit Union's West Virginia Headquarters along the Kanawha River, in Charleston, WV.

large shear wall vertical braces nearly 30 feet tall complete the facility. Each shear wall brace required foundation 10 feet wide by 20 feet long by 12 feet deep and, at 266 cubic yards, represented over 50% of the total foundation concrete.

This unique & open design, which allows for large sections of curtain wall glass, required 65 tons of structural steel in a relatively compact footprint. Three



Safety and Design

The exterior façade is a combination of Arriscraft thin-clad split face 8"x24" stone veneer, Dutch quality prestige weather ledge stone veneer & metal wall panels. Accents include pre-cast concrete windowsills & a metal wall panel wave that carries into the front edge of the drive-through canopy.

Porcelain tile greets guests as they enter the lobby where they will find Pioneer WV FCU's compass logo water-jet cut into the porcelain. Weather ledge stone veneer treatments to the interior columns & office walls tie the exterior façade to the interior finishes.

Project Duration:

- Eleven Months. Construction began in March of 2016 & was completed in February of 2017.

Project Safety:

- Jarrett Construction Services recorded no safety related incidents during the project's duration.
- Jarrett Construction Services held weekly toolbox safety meetings.
