




WVU Coliseum Renovation

Renovations to the WVU Coliseum started in January of 2016. This project's main focus was the concourse level, the admin level, shell area and men's & women's locker rooms. Several upgrades, including new light fixtures along the concourse area, were installed by Tri-County Electric staff.

This multi-purpose arena can seat up to 14,000 people and continues to host a variety of sporting events including WVU men's & women's basketball games, volleyball, wrestling matches, gymnastics competitions and public events such as concerts & summer camps.

Over forty high definition television monitors are now displayed throughout the coliseum, along with twelve new Daktronics LED boards that give the forty-seven-year-old facility a more up to date & lively appearance.

Safety and Design

Tri-County Electric and WVU worked closely to complete these renovations successfully & on-time. Considerable amounts of dedication & communications between Tri-County's experienced staff & other companies, including State Electric Supply, Co., provided necessary material to complete tasks in such a timely manner.

Meetings were scheduled every Wednesday, between contractors, to discuss the construction process, safety, & upcoming deadlines.



Project Duration:

- One Year. Construction began in January of 2016 & was completed in December of 2016.

- Tri-County Electric recorded no safety related incidents during the project's duration.
- Tri-County held both daily & weekly toolbox safety meetings.
