Industrial Construction: Less than \$5 Million

The Dominion Lightburn Tank Farm is an industrial facility located near Jane Lew, WV. Bear Construction utilized the expertise of several different contractors to construct the complex project under strict completion deadlines.

Self-performing 55% of the work involved, this project included a number of key elements and multifaceted components. Not only did the project require over 500 yards of concrete, it required the installation of new separation tanks, a compressor

station floor drainage tank, access roads, landscaping & sidewalks, electrical systems, control panels, tank piping, pumps and truck connections, crossover platforms and submerged roof drain piping.

Safety and Design

Bear Contracting worked closely with their own engineering team to find alternative building options for the facility. A three foot cut off wall was dug in conjunction with thickening the slab to combat sandy material found while preparing to install the footers and piers.

Despite poor weather conditions, Bear Contracting, LLC met all deadlines requested by Owner, Dominion Transmission Service. Bear's commitment to safety and attention to detail has always aided in their exceptional completion history.

Project Duration:

- Eight Months with construction being fully completed in November of 2016.
