With the number of women in government decreasing, we want to empower women to apply for appointments to reach gender equality on boards and commissions. Join us and be part of the movement.

Presenter, Rachel Michelin, is a leader of a statewide women's leadership organization committed to supporting, training and recruiting women to become active leaders in their communities. She has increased the organization's statewide brand by tripling membership, increasing the number of statewide chapters and increasing the organization's reach through an aggressive statewide outreach. Rachel's strong relationship with the Governor's office has empowered women to seek political appointments at the state level. She has conceptualized and executed a grassroots outreach campaign to educate and train women on how to apply and get appointed at the statewide level through the California Women's State Appointments Project, which became a national model for other women's political organizations. Rachel cultivates relationships with elected officials and staff at all levels of government, associations of elected officials, political organizations, other non-profits, the business community, and the public in order to promote the goals of California Women Lead and California Women Lead partners. She creates and trains women leaders on public policy issues including healthcare, energy, and economic development in order to encourage them to be advocates with their local communities and state.
