Dr. John Brose, Associated Clinic of Psychology, Creator of the Dementia Care Certificate Program of Minnesota

Dr. Brose has treated over 35,000 older adults during his career. Approximately 75% of them have had some cognitive impairment. Dr. Brose and his colleagues provide service to over 175 skilled nursing facilities, and he has designed a number of dementia units and other specialty units. Dr. Brose will present on 3 different topics including "Non-Medication Approaches for Dementia," "Increasing Behavioral Health Competence in Caregivers of Dementia Patients," and "Dementia Patients with Challenging Behavioral Health Issues." Dr. Brose uses metaphors in everyday language to explain complex concepts and has lectured on this topic in 48 of 50 states.



John Gale, Ordained Minister, BA - History; MA - Bible

During his 10 years of working as a Hospice Chaplain, he has provided emotional and spiritual counseling to patients and families before and after the patient has passed. His focus during his presentations is on the importance of sharing your thoughts and feelings rather than "stuffing" them. Grief that is suppressed becomes compressed. Another focus is on patients with dementia. This can make it incredibly challenging to communicate with them, "Where he has seen his greatest impact in this work, is being completely present with his patients and/ or their families concerning the process of letting go. It is at this point, that he learns how he can respond effectively and compassionately to them."
