A New Year - Let's Return to Proven Ancient Principles

Editorial

With the Start of a New Year, we think it appropriate to call for honesty in government and a return to the ruling principles and foundations that made this nation great for over 200 years. Thomas Jefferson referred to these as "The Ancient Principles". Those studied and proven principles designed to prevent lawlessness or a default to the rule of the jungle is foundational to our Constitution. The Ancient Principles lean upon the Ten Commandments and the Common Law. The Common Law has a long established history and, in simple terms, is just plain common sense and a moral code that has its roots in the Ten Commandments.

In 1776, Americans came out of bondage with faith, understanding and courage. Against great odds; we battled our way with sound ideas and much bloodshed to achieve liberty. Liberty is that delicate area between the force of government and freewill of man. Liberty brings freedom of choice to work, to trade, to travel and live wherever one wishes and it leads to abundance. Abundance, if made an end in itself, will result in complacency. One that recognizes the true "pecking order" of chain of command in this nation. 1. *God* created man 2. *Man* created the Constitution... 3. *Our Constitution* created government constrained by law... 4. *Government* created laws to rule the people via agencies and bureaucracies.

The base of power was always intended to remain in the hands of the people but can easily be lost to those acting in the name of government, such as politicians, bureaucrats, judges, lawyers, etc., Then what was designed to be a REPUBLIC can become an up for grabs tyranny or a pseudo democratic nation state. Democracies are vulnerable to manipulation and mob rule instead of a duly elected law-abiding representational government. A democracy is also dangerous because it is a one vote system as opposed to a three-vote system: three votes check tyranny, not just one. We have been poorly informed or misinformed of the other two votes.

Our first is at the polls on *Election Day* when we pick those to represent us in the seats of government. What happens when those officials just don't perform as expected?

The second is when you serve on a *Grand Jury* and can judge criminal activity. Before those acting in the name of government can bring anyone to trial for a capital or infamous



crime, permission must be obtained from people serving on a Grand Jury!

The third and most powerful vote is when you are acting as a *jury member* during a court trial. At this point, "**the buck stops**" with the people! Each juror has more power than the President, all of Congress, all the bureaucrats and all of the judges combined. Any juror can, with impunity, choose to disregard the instructions of any judge or attorney in rendering his vote on what is lawful.

Congress can make laws, the President or some other bureaucrat can make an order or issue regulations, and judges may make decisions, but no juror can ever be punished for voting "Not Guilty"! Any juror can, with impunity, choose to disregard the instructions of a judge or attorney and just one juror can say "Not Guilty" for any reason and there is no conviction and no punishment at the end of a trial. Under our Constitution, jurors have the right to judge both the facts of a case and the law as it is applied. That's the final word!

Given the illegal and egregious actions of many public officials today, it is time we demand a return to founding principles. *We The People* must use all three of our votes!

28 Principles of our Founders

The following is Part 2 of a brief overview of 28 principles outlined in *The 5,000 Year Leap* by Cleon Skousen. The book contains one chapter devoted to each of these 28 principles and is an excellent source for study. Principles 1-4 were presented in the December 2017 issue. This month covers Principles 5-10.

Principle 5. *All things were created by God, therefore upon Him all mankind are equally dependent, and to Him they are equally responsible.*



The Founders considered the existence of the Creator as the most fundamental premise underlying *all* self-evident truth. The words Nature's God, Creator, created, Supreme

Judge of the Universe, and Divine Providence are used throughout the Declaration of Independence.

Principle 6. *All men are created equal.*
(An exact quote from the second paragraph of the Declaration of Independence)

Principle 7. *The proper role of government is to protect equal rights, not provide equal things.*
"-That to secure these rights, governments are instituted among men." (Second paragraph of the Declaration of Independence)

Principle 8. *Men are endowed by their Creator with certain unalienable rights.*
(Second paragraph of the Declaration of Independence)

Principle 9. *To protect man's rights, God has revealed certain principles of divine law.*
The Founders knew that God had revealed certain laws for human happiness, such as laws against killing, stealing, adultery, lying, coveting, etc. These are reflected in the right of man to form a government to protect his unalienable rights of life, liberty, and property outlined in the Declaration and the Bill of Rights.

Principle 10. *The God-given right to govern is vested in the sovereign authority of the whole people.*

The last paragraph of the Declaration makes it clear that the people *as a whole*, by their representatives in Congress, have complete authority from the Supreme Judge of the Universe to govern themselves in every way and to take their rightful place among the sovereign peoples of the earth.

Antifa – What Americans Needs To Know

"Antifa" dominates today's headline, from swarming conservative speakers to attacking Trump supporters attending the President's rallies. Yet, though these masked, violent radicals are more numerous and prominent than ever, they are poorly understood. Claiming to oppose "racism" and "fascism," they are widely excused by the news media, and even some Republicans, as extremists pursuing a good cause.

Fascism is an ultra-nationalist ideology that mobilizes around and glorifies a national or perceived racial identity, valuing this identity above all other interests. Fascism is marked by its hostility towards reason and human solidarity, by its dehumanization and scapegoating of marginalized or oppressed groups, and by its use of violence or threat of violence.

In most major cities, wearing a Make America Great Again hat (hardly a sign of a dictatorship) will put you at risk from physical attack.

The greatest danger of Antifa is that its definition of "fascism" and "racism" are so broad that almost anyone or everyone can be

(Multiculturalism - Continued from Page 1) included. Mark Bray, a Dartmouth professor and major supporter of the movement, sneers, "our goal should be that in twenty years those who voted for Trump are too uncomfortable to share their face in public. We may not always



be able to change someone's belief, but we sure as hell can make it politically, socially, economically, and sometimes physically costly to articulate them."

According to the Antifa definition of Fascist or oppressive ideas, the vast majority of all human beings everywhere, at all times and through all history, are rendered proto-fascists. "Racism" is another word meaning one thing to Antifa and something entirely different to almost everyone else. Most define "racism" as hating people because of their ethnic or racial origin. To Antifa, "racism" means failing to support a sweeping program of social revolution to dismantle Western Civilization itself.

All Americans must understand three critical points. (1) "Anti-fascism" exists to pave the way for a revolutionary socialist alternative. It isn't paving the way for liberal democracy to function more smoothly. (2) There is an implied hatred of all white people as "racist," against whom violence is justified. 

Climate Change Alarmism is "Garbage In, Garbage Out"

Unsubstantiated claims about global warming that prevent policymakers from making "rational decisions" with regard to the development of U.S. energy resources have become a national security threat, says Hal Doiron, a 16-year NASA veteran. The "propaganda" underpinning climate alarmism is "causing tremendous political bottlenecks" that prevent government officials from "doing the right thing" on energy, he said. Doiron also expressed concern that the U.S. military had been directly affected by climate alarmist claims separated from sound science.

He criticized the Navy for "preparing for something that is unreasonable and would cost too much money" in the form of "extreme sea-level rise," which has not been borne out by rigorous scientific study. "At NASA, you don't make critical decisions based on 'garbage in, garbage out.' Yet our government has been doing that with respect to



climate alarm, because too many academics in universities are writing papers and drawing

conclusions from models that don't agree with physical data."

Doiron is part of a group called "The Right Climate Stuff," which includes engineers and scientists from across generations. The group

(Climate Change - Continued from Page 2) has produced its own "rigorous, earth surface temperature model using conservation-of-energy principles. The reports produced from the analysis provide more "realistic projections" of the rise in the earth's surface temperature over the next 150 years that show severe anti-fossil fuel regulations are not justified, the team members contend.

Doiron, the retired NASA physicist is calling for U. S. policymakers to establish official data on two (2) key metrics; specifically, "the true sensitivity of surface temperature to greenhouse gases" and a "reasonable projection of greenhouse emissions and the concentrations rise in our atmosphere."


Admiral Thomas Hayward, retired from the Navy as Chief of Naval Operations and a member of the Joint Chiefs of Staff after serving as commander of the 7th Fleet and commander in chief of the Pacific Fleet said for the past six to eight years, climate change has been given "a higher priority" than the readiness of the Navy's fleet. The Defense Dept has spent \$100 billion on "just climate change," while the Navy spent "\$58 billion.

But, because policymakers and military planners are not operating from reasonable projections, they are not in a position to adequately plan for the future, Doiron cautioned.

A True American

An American patriot born January 1, 1735, studied at North Grammar School, Boston, MA, learned the silver smithing trade. Served in the French and Indian War in 1756. Afterward he married and entered his father's silver smith business. His first wife passed away leaving him with 8 children, he remarried and fathered 8 more children. He engraved a number of political cartoons that got wide attention. He cast bullets for cannons and later

church bells; he invented sheet copper.

He soon became interested in the movement for independence. He was one of fifty workers who took part in the Boston Tea Party on Dec. 16, 1773. He galloped to Concord in April 1775 to warn the patriots to move their military supplies. Two days later, he carried news to Lexington of the approach of the British. He warned the patriot leaders Samuel Adams, John Hancock, and the Minute Men of their danger and called the men of the countryside to arms.

News came that a detachment of 700 soldiers under the command of General Thomas Gage, Commander in Chief of the Massachusetts Bay Colony (British), were to go to Concord to destroy supplies and armaments, and Adams and Hancock were to be arrested. Our patriot and William Dawes arranged for a signal to be flashed from a church steeple to warn Adams and Hancock and the Patriots at Concord. Two lanterns meant that the British

were coming by water, and one lantern if by land.

In the years following he worked to ratify the Constitution. He designed and printed the first issue of Continental paper currency. He made the state seal which is still used by Massachusetts; he cast cannon for the army; developed considerable skill for printing and engraving; many of his bells he cast are still in use; he made the copper fittings for the U.S.S. Constitution and fine silver dishes made by him are highly prized by collectors today; many museums have examples of his metalwork. The Boston Massacre was one of his famous engravings.

From 1776 to 1779 our patriot commanded a garrison at Castle William in Boston Harbor. In 1779 he commanded artillery in the Penobscot Expedition.

He died at the age of 83 in the year 1818 of natural causes. An obituary in the Boston Intelligence stated, "seldom has the tomb closed upon a life so honorable and useful."

A long-ago hero, Paul Revere lived a full, exciting, and fruitful life.

Not In My Backyard

In California, a case of "we were here first, we don't need or want you" is painfully obvious when bills that allow homeowners to add additional units on their properties fail and neighborhood groups fight increased housing supply because it means greater density.

California is facing a housing crisis. The lefty state is starting to struggle with their environmentalist stance on everything, which is being challenged by runaway growth and their sanctuary position that everyone is welcomed.

The state's average home price of \$459,000 is more than double what it is nationally. The state has failed to increase low-income housing. Low-income households in California spend half their salaries on housing. Homelessness is surging across the state. People are living in vans hidden away in quiet neighborhoods with makeshift kitchens. Silicon Valley, a symbol of wealth and technology, has lines of parked RV's as evidence of the challenge of finding an affordable place to call home.

No this is not Bangladesh! It's literally a low income housing community in San Francisco. California's noble ideas of welcome seem little more than pretense when both low income and even the wealthy cannot find affordable housing.

As we travel more and have additional experiences – Mrs. Funmeister and myself have learned that minor league sports activities actually can be as much or more fun than their major league counterparts.

Our journey began this year with some trips to the Class A Florida Firefrogs baseball games in Kissimmee, which we also wrote about on the Florida Fun Zone page.

What a great time! The prices were right and in many ways it is reminiscent of the baseball of our youth.

They started with pre-game ceremonies including the National Anthem and the announcement of the players.

The games are truly exciting as these young men are looking to advance, so they are playing their hearts out each game - running, hitting and diving for the ball. We did see one rather listless left-fielder but by the next game he was gone.

One of the games we saw was decided in the bottom of the ninth with a grand slam home run to win it for the Frogs.

Another advantage was access to the players. Kids would routinely run down and give the players high-fives and we walked over to the bullpen so my wife could speak with a pitcher who attended the same college as she.

Moreover, the prices are right. You can get a couple hot dogs, chips and two sodas for about the same price as a beer at a major league game, and tickets for both of us were less than half the price for one person at a major league game. Incidentally, the team merchandise also is about as reasonably priced.

We found the same thing in the racing world. Of course, Florida is loaded with short tracks where the action meets or surpasses

NASCAR at a fraction of the price. Recently we went to the second annual Pistons & Props road-racing event at the Sebring International Raceway. Again, for a fraction of the price of their legendary Mobil One 12 Hours of Sebring, we had a chance to see dozens of different kinds of vehicles on and off the track.

The cars were easily accessible in the paddock and we found many of the owners were eager to talk about these vintage and historic cars - some of which actually ran at Sebring in the past.

One owner invited Mrs Funmeister to climb into his racecar and get a feel for it (sadly, he did not let her drive it).

Watching the race is a breeze as there are a lot fewer fans and there are many places to watch - such as their elevated pit structure, viewing mounds and simply standing along the fence line.

So if you are on a budget, even if you are not particularly a sports fan, the minor leagues in the Sunshine State can provide major enjoyment at affordable prices. Take a look around your area, there probably is a minor league
