
## Ukulele

That may seem like a lot of songs for one class, but Eli was teaching Medleys that day — how to make one song blend into another. "It's nice to have the same key for medleys," he says.

During class Eli reminds everyone how to properly hold their instrument, and advises the students to do exercises to strengthen their fingers. Students are very enthusiastic and help each other out with fingering tips.

The class plays together and then towards the end there is an "open mic" session where anyone who has a "pocket song" (a song they know well enough to play) can perform for the group.
