OVERVIEW OF SCHEDULE FOR WOMEN'S CAMP

Sunday: Registration begins at 3 p.m. During the afternoon there will be Hospitality & Fellowship, Orientation for our First Timers, Dinner, Vespers, a short program, Get Acquainted Activities, a Snack and Lights Out at 10:30 p.m.

Monday: We begin our day at 7 a.m., there is a Morning Watch at 7:30 a.m. and then Breakfast at 8 a.m. During the morning hours there will be singing and the first of our Messages from Doris Abdullah. There will be Special Interest Activities from 10:45-11:45 a.m. and then Lunch. In the afternoon, we will have Singing, another message from Doris Abdullah, Snack, and time again for Special Interest Activities from 3:15-4:15 p.m. Supper is at 5 p.m. In the evening we will have Vespers, Fellowship Time, a Campfire, Snack and Lights Out at 10:30 a.m.

Tuesday: We begin our day again at 7 a.m., with Morning Watch and Breakfast at the same time as above. We will sing together, hear from Doris Abdullah, and enjoy participating in the Special Interest Activities again. Lunch is at noon. After lunch we will sing, hear a final message from Doris Abdullah and then have a closing and departure at 2 p.m.
