As part of the implementation, we have given you access to the free *SecurlyHOME* app. Starting next week you will be able to download the App. The following week, you'll start to receive a weekly email report with samples of your child's online activity over the previous week.

Step 1: Download the SecurlyHOME App after October 10, 2018

Step 2: Open the App and click on the "send me a link" button.

- A link will be sent to the email address you have registered with your child's school.
- Once you've clicked the link, you'll be taken to the SecurlyHOME App. Your account is ready to go!






Step 3: Explore and Configure


• SecurlyHOME lets you access your account information from anywhere, in real-time.




Get a real-time view of your child's online activity.
