- 4. Nominee must be a resident, business, government, academic or not-for-profit organization located in Northwest Florida, specifically, the counties of Escambia, Santa Rosa, Okaloosa, Walton, Washington, Holmes, Bay, Gulf, Calhoun, and Jackson Counties.

Environmental Professional of the Year

1. Environmental Professional of the Year Awards are reserved for individuals who have demonstrated the following:

- Defining the environmental problem or need
- Efforts taken to address the environmental problem or need
- Accomplishment of stated goals
- Measurable and lasting public health or environmental benefits
- Collaboration with others
- Promotion of innovative ideas or approaches
- Ability of the program/activity to be replicated or widely shared
- Clarity and effectiveness of the presentation

 - Nominees for the EPOY will be for a project that is currently in progress, has been completed within the previous two years, OR will be started by 12/30/2017.
 - Environmental Impact: The project will have a measurable beneficial impact on some portion of the ecosystem air, water, groundwater, soil, habitat quality/quantity, flora or fauna population.
 - Partnerships: The nomination information shall include a description of any partnerships being utilized to achieve the project's goals.
 - Innovativeness: The project description should include any new technologies and/or environmental theories being employed.
 - Funding: A description of how the project is being funded initially, and how the funding is sustained (if applicable), shall be included in the nomination form.
