



Vestavia Country Club, located in Birmingham, Alabama, can provide a unique opportunity for interns to learn and grow their knowledge of the golf course industry.

Vestavia is a 27-hole, private country club nestled in the foothills of the Appalachian Mountains. An intern will get vast knowledge working on various types of turf - both cool season and warm season.

On the 18-hole championship course, which was fully renovated in 2017, interns will work with AU Victory bentgrass greens, fine fescue rough, Zorro zoysia tees and fairways, and 419 Bermuda rough.

On the 9-hole par 3 course interns will work with mini-verde Bermuda greens, and 419 Bermuda tees, approaches, and rough.

Program: In addition to normal maintenance tasks, the interns will be trained on a new turf management practice each week, including but not limited to:

- Daily course set up, including greens mowing, fairway mowing, bunker maintenance, tee and approach mowing, greens rolling, changing hole locations, marking course
- Greens aeration and organic matter management
- Sprayer and fertilizer calibration and application
- Weed, disease, and insect identification and management
- Greens moisture management
- Fertility and soil testing
- Irrigation management, working with Rainbird IC system and Toro satellite system, both HDPE and PVC pipe
- Mower set-up and equipment maintenance with equipment manager
- Work with new technologies in golf maintenance management including: Task Tracker, Playbooks , ezLocator, and Trello
