DURING THIS INTERACTIVE COURSE PARTICIPANTS WILL LEARN HOW TO:

- ✓ **COMMUNICATE** effectively with solicitors, strangers, family and friends
- ✓ **IDENTIFY** an emergency or potentially dangerous situation
- ✓ **RECOGNIZE** exploitation on the phone, social media (texting and sexting), or in the mail

Students will **CREATE** a personal portfolio with pictures and notes to reference after completing the course. The portfolio provides a recap of information including: when to call 911, when and how to say NO, topics that are/aren't appropriate to discuss in social settings. Participants will also engage in role playing activities and interact with invited guest speakers (e.g., law enforcement).
