

Data from Western cultures has consistently shown that less than 20% prefer learning by reading. This means that a whopping 80% of people in our modern society would rather learn new information via non-traditional means. In this workshop, we will show you how easy it is to learn and tell, and remember Bible stories. We will talk about how to prepare and lead a group discussion, or simply share a story with an acquaintance as an evangelism tool. We will introduce the process of preparing an oral inductive Bible study without pen, paper, or your computer through meditation on God's Word, and sweet time conferring with the Holy Spirit. Fresh Expressions is a term to describe a new "Spirit led idea" of reaching others and creating a church around people who probably aren't or won't attend our existing churches.
