Revelation 3:14-22

**1. Look who’s talking – Jesus’ final message.**

(14) “To the angel of the church in Laodicea write: These are the words of the **Amen**, the faithful and true **witness**, the **ruler** of God’s creation. (cf. Colossians 4:17)

- The \_\_\_\_\_ – His words are true beyond any doubt
- The \_\_\_\_\_ – speaking sincerely and truthfully about what he knows, sees, and hears
- The \_\_\_\_\_ – the One from whom all things find their beginning—He has primacy over all—He created all things and holds all things together (cf. Col. 1:15-20)

**2. Jesus’ \_\_\_\_\_ of their progress.**

Revelation 3:15-17

**4. Jesus’ \_\_\_\_\_ to those who overcome.**

(Revelation 3:21-22) **To him who overcomes**, I will give the right to sit with me on my throne, just as I overcame and sat down with my Father on his throne. He who has an ear, let him hear what the Spirit says to the churches.”
