



Today: "When It's Time to Pray"

Matthew 6:9-13

- ✓ **Desperation** redefined: The collision of two biblical truths; we are limited, God is unlimited
- ✓ **Desperation** is meant to be a lifestyle, not just a response in crisis
- ✓ **Desperation** inspires people to cry out, call out, to pray to this unlimited God, who hears and answers their prayers



1. Desperately pray \_\_\_\_\_ (Reverence).

Matthew 6:9

2. Desperately pray \_\_\_\_\_ (Response).

Matthew 6:10

- Prayer is \_\_\_\_\_ about establishing our kingdom or our purposes. (James 4:3)
- Prayer \_\_\_\_\_ about establishing God's Kingdom and His purposes.
