Jesus' commendation:

I know your **deeds**, your **hard work** and your **perseverance**. I know that you **cannot tolerate** wicked men, that you have **tested** those who claim to be apostles but are not, and have found them false.³ You have **persevered** and have **endured hardships** for my name, and have **not grown weary**.⁶ But you have this in your favor: **You hate** the practices of the Nicolaitans, which I also hate. (Revelation 2:2-3, 6)

Jesus' correction:

(4) Yet I hold **this** against you: You have **forsaken your first love**.

3. Jesus' provides a _____ for their spiritual drift.

(5) **Remember** the height from which you have fallen! **Repent** and **do** the things you did at first. If you do not repent, I will come to you and remove your lampstand from its place.
