

**Last week's focus:**

Jesus' clear teaching about the person and work of the Holy Spirit, in John 14-16, revealed that the Spirit would come in a brand-new way, would continue what Jesus had begun, would confirm truth about Jesus, would be an advantage to the disciples and that He would exalt Jesus, not Himself.

**After His resurrection ...**

**1. Jesus \_\_\_\_\_ with the disciples for \_\_\_\_\_ days.**

(Acts 1:1-3)

Why didn't Jesus go to heaven right after His resurrection?

- His disciples were not \_\_\_\_\_ for Him to leave or for the Spirit to come.
- \_\_\_\_\_ & \_\_\_\_\_ impacts the power of the Holy Spirit in/through a believers' life, then and now. (cf. Ephesians 4:20, 1 Thessalonians 5:19)

**2. Jesus gave His disciples \_\_\_\_\_ instructions and then went back to heaven, leaving them alone for 10 more days.**

(Acts 1:4-8)

- Don't go anywhere, stay in Jerusalem, \_\_\_\_\_ for the coming of the Holy Spirit.

- Keep the \_\_\_\_\_ thing the main thing; don't get distracted by non-essentials.

**3. The Spirit came \_\_\_\_\_, just as Jesus promised in John 14-16.**

(Acts 2:2-28:31)
