

FOLDER ON World War 1 Directions for Project

You will be making a folder of the important facts about World War 1.

This project will be due _____. Following the directions carefully is important. The grading rubric for the finalized folder is below on this page.

FRONT PAGE

Design a collage, picture or emblem that represents World War 1. Include the title “the Great War 1914-1918”. At the bottom of the front page, write a sentence that explains what the war was all about. Write your name on the front page.

SECOND PAGE

On this page, you will attach the envelope with the essay about what led up to World War 1. A timeline will be developed on this page which includes these dates and brief information about the importance of the events that occurred: June 28, 1914; July 28-August 4 1914; May 7, 1915; May 23, 1915; December 7, 2016; April 6, 2017; December 5, 2017; July 15, 1918; October 29- November 9, 1918; November 11, 2018; June 28, 1919. On this page attach an envelope with an essay of 300+ words that explains the practice of developing alliances among nations and what part those alliances contributed to the size of the war.

THIRD PAGE

Place a map showing the countries that were involved in the war. The key of the map should show by color the Triple Alliance, the Triple Entente members as well as the neutral countries. Mark where the initial battles began and also show the location of the “Western Front.”

Prepare illustrations of the uniforms worn by British, Americans, Russians and Germans. Any other country’s soldier uniforms are extra credit. Also show weapons and artillery used during this conflict.

Include an explanation of what event(s) marked turning points of the war (300 + essay).

Show pictures of important leaders during this war. Include their titles and brief explanations about their contributions.

FOURTH (BACK) PAGE

Tell about the terms of the peace treaty that was signed, (the Treaty of Versailles.) (100+ words)

Tell about the League of Nations and why the U.S. did not join it. (200+ words)

Display pictures of the signing of the Treaty, and a map that shows the new nations that were formed in Europe as a result of the World War 1.

Include an article that features something unusual about the war that might be considered of “human interest”. Explain
