Love Always Prevails

Rebecca Libed, our Assistant Director of Stewardship, shares about the impact of Middle's LGBTQ equality work on her life and family.

Eighteen years ago, I came out to my mom. She did not take it well and showed me a brochure she received from her church saying that same-sex relationships were a sin. I was lost and alone. Fast forward 18 years, my partner of nine years and I decided to get married. When I told my mom, she threw our save-the-date card on the floor. Some of my family members were supportive, but many were not. I lived in a haze of sadness for almost a year.

But what was different from when I came out of the closet? Now I wasn't alone. I had a loving partner by my side, and I had a community of #RevolutionaryLove at Middle Church. One day in the height of my sadness, the Rev. Dr. Jacqui Lewis asked me a simple question: "How are you?" Little did she expect me to burst into hysterical tears. I told her my story, and her reply is what got me through my 12-month journey: "Believe in the love between Ilana and you. And believe in the love God has for you."

It is that love and support of my Ilana and this community that helped me through an incredibly difficult time. In June, Jacqui officiated as I married my soulmate, Ilana, and my mom was there to bear witness. Many of my family members and loved ones also finally sided with their love for me. And at the end of our wedding weekend, my stepmom-in-law said to my mom, "Wasn't this great, Terry?" My mom responded emphatically, "It wasn't great, it was PERFECT!"

#RevolutionaryLove is protesting out in our streets, but it also transforms the core of our most intimate relationships. My life has experienced real and fundamental change through Middle Church. Love always prevails at the end.
