FAITH WEEKEND OF ACTION AGAINST ECOLOGICAL DEVASTATION JUNE 1-4, 2018

June 1st marks the beginning of hurricane season. Join faith communities as we raise our voices to demand accountability and action in recovery efforts by the government to address ecological devastation and remind the nation that there is no Planet B. If you're in NYC, join us on the evening of **Friday, June 1st** for *Decolonizing Faith: What's Next for Puerto Rico?* and on **Saturday, June 2nd** for *No Refuge from the Storm: Rally at the United Nations* where we will demand that the UN Audit the Debt and Audit the Deaths!

A newly released Harvard study found that 5,000+ Puerto Ricans died as a result of Hurricane Maria and government inaction, surpassing the combined death tolls of both Hurricane Katrina and the 9/11 attacks. Collective Action for Puerto Rico will conduct the following actions this weekend and demand that the U.N.'s Special Committee on Decolonization audit the 5,000+ deaths of Puerto Ricans after Hurricane Maria: Stay tuned for updates and the latest on our collective actions here: <http://bit.ly/AUDITTHEDEBT>.

As the [Souls of Poor Folks Audit](#) states, Puerto Rico's poverty rate was 43.5% before Hurricane Maria, compared to about 13% nationwide. We need a Poor People's Campaign and a National Call for Moral Revival to decolonize Puerto Rico and build resilient communities!

- Puerto Rico has nearly 3X more poverty than the United States. The poverty rate in Puerto Rico in 2016 for all people was 43.5%. In comparison, the poverty rate in the US was 14%. The poverty rate for children under the age of 5 in Puerto Rico is a shocking 64%, compared to 21.3% in the United States. #PuertoRico #AuditTheDebt #AuditThePRDeaths #NoRefuge Join Us: <http://bit.ly/AUDITTHEDEBT>
- Puerto Rico's public education system is threatened by a planned closing of 283 of its schools, leaving families without access to a key community resource and forcing children to travel long distances to school everyday. #PuertoRico #AuditTheDebt #AuditThePRDeaths Join Us: <http://bit.ly/AUDITTHEDEBT>
- Puerto Ricans pay taxes without representation in Congress and are subject to the US draft.
