## HOT CAKES V Stitch Cowl



**Approximate Measurements:** 70" x 9"

### Materials:

**Hot cakes- 1 – 200g cake**

**Shown on color 7- Beach Brights Mix**

**Gauge:** ~14 sts = 4" in V stitch pattern.

**Hook:** Size I hook.

**V Stitch (Vst)** – Work (1 dc, ch 1, 1 dc) into same stitch.

**Begin:** Chain 37.

**Row 1:** Work dc into the 4th ch from hook (the first 3 ch count as a dc), ch 1, skip next st, \*(work Vst into the next st, skip 2 sts); repeat from \* across until there are 4 sts left, ch 1, skip 2 sts, 1 dc into the last 2 sts, turn. (there will be 10 Vsts, and 4 dc sts across the row).

**Row 2:** Ch 3 (counting as first dc), skip first st, 1 dc into the next st, ch 1, \*(skip next dc, Vst into the next chain space); repeat from \* across until there are 3 dc left, skip the next dc, ch 1, 1 dc into the next st, 1 dc into the top of turning chain, turn. (10 Vsts, 4 dc sts) Repeat Row 2 until almost out of yarn. Fasten off. Sew the 2 ends together to make a cowl. Can also be left as a scarf. Weave in all ends.

ABBREVIATIONS: k = knit, k2tog= knit two sts together, p = purl, p2tog = purl 2 sts together, RS= right side, st(s) = stitch(es), WS = wrong side, yo= yarn over, ch = chain, sk = skip, dc= double crochet, st(s) = stitch(es), sp = space, m1 = make 1 st = lift bar onto needle, knit into the back of it to increase 1 st., Kf&b = knit into the front and the back of the stitch.
