

Shipping Your F3015 Lithium-ion Battery

Infaco wants to make shipping your shear for Annual Maintenance as painless as possible. Whether you ship your shear to California, Michigan, or New York this year, you should be aware that the F3015 lithium-ion battery is 120 Watt Hours. This means the battery is regulated and needs to be shipped accordingly.

1. Always put the battery in sleep mode prior to shipping. (See page 11 of your user's guide).
2. Pack the battery in the red case by placing it in the designated cut-out that is shaped like the battery. Do not pack it in a way where the plug area could come in contact with anything or where the battery could shift during transport. If you have an extra battery, wrap it in bubble wrap such that the plug cannot come into contact with anything during shipping.
3. Affix 3 things to the outside of the package:
 - Shipping label (TOP of package)
 - Lithium Battery Handling Label (1 SIDE of package)
 - Lithium Battery Forbidden Marking (1 SIDE of package)
