Our Vision

A community where all adolescents in crisis have a safe place to stay in an environment that promotes healthy family relationships.

Our Mission

Provide temporary shelter for runaways and youth in crisis, enabling them to come through the crisis with increased personal strength and a sense of renewal while in a supportive environment, with family reunification as a primary goal.

Our Program

We provide immediate care to youth who are homeless, abandoned, neglected, abused, or in need of a family cooling-off period. Our shelter operates around the clock, so we are open to any youth who find themselves in crisis or on the street. Casa Youth Shelter is licensed by the California Department of Social Services, Community Care Licensing Division.

- Emergency shelter for all genders ages 12-17 from all geographic areas
- 24/7 crisis line and intake availability
- Voluntary teen program with short-term residency
- Individual, group, and family counseling
- Educational tutoring
- Developmental activities for residents including recreation, pet and art therapy
- Aftercare and non-residential counseling
- Case management and referral services
- Volunteer opportunities for high school students and adults
- Undergraduate fieldwork and MFT Trainee / MSW Intern positions
- Parenting classes in English and Spanish (Court-approved by OC Probation/OC Social Service Agency)
