Friday, October 20th – 8:00 – 12:00 p.m.: Stress, The Brain, The Subluxation & The Adjustment

This course covers neuroanatomy of spinal mechanoreceptors, neuroanatomy of spinal sympathetic nervous system, neurophysiology of the somato-sympathetic reflex and its suprasegmental controls, and the mechano-neurophysical effects of the spinal adjustment.

Friday, October 20th – 1:30 – 5:30 p.m.: The Opiate Drug Crisis and the Chiropractic Alternative

Learn the Epley maneuver for BPPV, the distraction technique for Temporomandibular Dysfunction, the uncinate process adjustment, and the Pettibon #2 lumbosacral adjustment.
