

KENTLANDS® CLUBHOUSE POOL RULES

1. No person shall enter the pool area unless the pool is officially open and a lifeguard is on duty. The pool is open from 9:30 am to 9:00 pm daily.
2. Absolutely **NO DIVING** anywhere on the premises.
3. **NO FOOD OR BEVERAGES** anywhere on the main pool deck (only plastic water and Gatorade bottles are allowed). Food is allowed on the upper pool deck and snack bar patio and balcony.
4. Glass is not permitted anywhere on the pool deck or surrounding areas.
5. All children under the age of 12 must be accompanied by an adult (16 years or older). Children that are 10 and 11 may use the pool without adult supervision if a parental consent form is on file at the Clubhouse and the child has passed a swim test administered by the lifeguard staff.
6. All infants and toddlers who are not toilet trained must wear diapers and rubber pants while in any of the pools.
7. Absolutely no changing diapers on the pool deck. Diaper changing areas are available in the locker rooms.
8. Adult (16 years or older) swim is 45 minutes after the hour for 15 minutes, from 10:45 am to 7:45 pm only.
9. Only beach balls, nerf balls and noodles are permitted in the social and wading pools, except on raft nights. Lifeguards may, at their discretion and for safety reasons, limit the number of these items in the pool. Water guns are not permitted.
10. Kickboards may be used in the lap pool and in the social pool only as instructional aids, as they otherwise present a safety hazard.
11. All infants or young children using flotation devices of any kind must stay within arm's reach of an adult while in the water. Pull over flotation devices are strictly prohibited.
12. Absolutely **NO RUNNING** on the pool deck.
13. Dunking, pushing, wrestling or horseplay will not be tolerated.
14. All patrons must shower before entering the pool. Showers are limited to 5 minutes.
15. Smoking, drugs and alcohol are not permitted anywhere on the grounds of the Kentlands Clubhouse. Persons under the influence of drugs or alcohol will be barred from the pool.
16. Only children 6 years of age or under may use the wading pool. Adults are solely responsible for all children at all times.
17. Please stay off lifelines and lane ropes.
18. No chairs are allowed in the pools or on the pool ramp.
19. Please return chairs to their original positions and clean the area around you before leaving the pool area.
20. For the safety and protection of others, admission may be denied to anyone with coughs, colds, contagious conditions, inflamed eyes, infections, skin abrasions or anyone wearing bandages.
21. Wet bathing suits are not allowed in the Clubhouse Great Room or fitness room.
22. Pool patrons shall lodge complaints initially to the lifeguards and/or pool manager on duty. If the inquiry or complaint is not resolved, the patron should contact the CMC Management office during regular business hours.
23. Failure to comply with these rules will result in warnings and subsequent suspension.
24. Lifeguards and/or Management shall have the authority to suspend any pool patron from the pool for up to 15 days for any violation of the rules.

These rules may be revised and amended at any time at the discretion of Management without prior notice.
