





SCHEDULE OF EVENTS

Gather at Trinity United Methodist Church, 265 Washington Street, SW, Atlanta, GA 30303, (immediately down the street from the State Capitol).

9:00 a.m.: Registration/Continental Breakfast

9:30 a.m. – 10:45 a.m.: Orientation and Legislative Briefings. You'll receive your ICM "Hearts for Children" badge, advocacy training and information to provide to your legislators.

- If you have pre-registered, we will provide you with the names and locations of your legislators when you arrive.
- If you did not pre-register, we will help you determine who your legislators are after the morning briefings.
- If you have already looked up and called your legislators "Way to go!"

NOTE: THESE ACTIVITIES WILL BE REPEATED THROUGHOUT THE DAY.

The goal is to have delegations of like-district attendees make group visits to their legislators.

Once delegations are sorted, you will proceed to calling on your legislators and engaging them in discussions on ICM's priority issues regarding our children.

Before Feb. 15, call your State Representative and State Senator and let them know that you will be at the Capitol on Feb. 15. You can find out who they are by visiting <http://mvp.sos.state.ga.us/>.

AFTER ORIENTATION

After Orientation, if you have made pre-scheduled appointment(s), then you may proceed to your legislators' offices (or other agreed upon meeting place).

AFTER SPEAKING W/YOUR LEGISLATORS

Once you have completed your meeting, please return to the Orientation Room at Trinity United Methodist Church for a debriefing session, your ICM Day at the Capitol t-shirt and light snacks.

The Orientation Room will be open all day. Please see an ICM volunteer once you arrive.
