Please join us for a day-long seminar focused on supporting breastfeeding for **term**, **preterm**, and **NICU babies** and their parents.

There is a difference between recommending a mother breastfeed and **actively promoting and supporting breastfeeding**, especially when the mother is experiencing difficulties. We will explore breastfeeding-supportive ways of addressing common infant challenges to establishing and maintaining breastfeeding.

Physicians and other healthcare providers' recognition of breastfeeding basics and the **evidence behind the BFHI Ten Steps** can make a vital difference in breastfeeding success.

Dr. Nancy Wight is an attending Neonatologist with San Diego Neonatology, Inc. and is the Medical Director for Sharp HealthCare Lactation Services in San Diego, CA. She is board-certified in Pediatrics and Neonatal-Perinatal Medicine and has been an IBCLC since 1988.

She is currently secretary and education coordinator for the San Diego County Breastfeeding Coalition, which she helped found. Nancy is the Breastfeeding Coordinator for District IX, Chapter 3 of the American Academy of Pediatrics. She is a past president of the Academy of Breastfeeding Medicine, and on Board of HMBANA. Her book, "Best Medicine: Human Milk in the NICU" was published in July 2008.
