



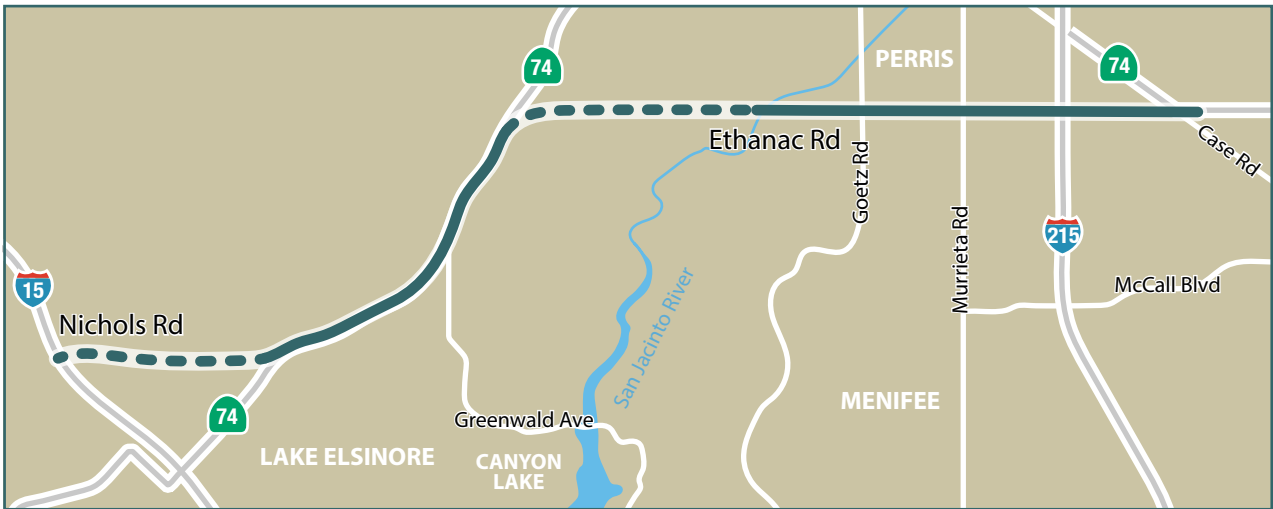
Ethanac Expressway: Community Input Wanted

Overview

The County of Riverside is conducting a Corridor Vision study for the proposed Ethanac Expressway – a corridor between Interstate 15 at Nichols Road and east of Interstate 215 and Ethanac Road. The current Corridor Vision and Project Development phase is expected to be completed in late 2018 and aims to:

- Develop a short term and long term vision for the corridor that connect I-15 and I-215
- Recommend features for the corridor including:
 - Number of lanes
 - Intersection spacing
 - Bicycle lanes and routes
 - Bus stop routes and stops
 - Future public transit uses
 - Pedestrian uses
 - Multi-trail uses
- Develop an appropriate strategy for phasing the improvements
- Define what improvements are needed in each segment
- Determine the priority order of the improvements
- Recommend studies to be performed in the future
