What does it mean to be a member of the Chamber of Commerce?

A chamber of commerce (or board of trade) is a form of business network, for example, a local organization of businesses whose goal is to further the interests of businesses.

Local businesses are members, and they elect a board of directors or executive council to set policy for the chamber.

How much does it cost to be a member of the Chamber of Commerce?

The **average cost of membership depends on the size** and number of employees your business has. Many small business memberships fall into the \$30-40 per month range. **Most chambers charge a \$300- \$400 yearly fee.** (Here is Floresville the chamber membership fees are \$125-\$325. That equates to \$10.41 to \$27.08 per month or .35—.90 a day depending on you fee structure).

Chambers of Commerce are not in the business to make money per se. They receive a good portion of the money to operate (rent, salaries, utilities, etc.) through the membership fees to join the chamber and by holding activities and functions that benefit businesses with a nominal cost to participate or attend.

The affairs of the Chamber shall be managed by its Board of Directors. The Board of Directors shall have control of and be responsible for the management of the affairs and property of the Corporation.

The chamber belongs to **YOU** its members, you are voluntary paying members of the chamber. Chamber does have a set of by-laws set forth by the last board of directors. They are the same by-law set forth by most chambers across the nation
