
NEWS & NOTES

- •La Salle men's basketball heads west for its next three games at the Wooden Legacy Tournament in California.
- •The Explorers will face Miami (Fla.) in the opening round of the event on Thanksgiving Day, beginning at 2:30 p.m. ET.
- •On Friday, the opponent will be either Northwestern or Fresno State before the event concludes on Sunday with a game against Seton Hall, Grand Canyon, Hawaii or Utah.
- •This past Saturday, La Salle dropped an 89-84 decision to city foe Drexel at Tom Gola Arena.
- •Graduate student Pookie Powell scored 21 points for the second consecutive game while grabbing seven rebounds, all of which came on the defensive end.
- For the first time this season, the Explorers won the battle of the boards (37-35), but the Dragons went to the free-throw line 40 times (converting 34).
- •Another grad student, transfer Cheddi Mosely, had his best game in Blue & Gold, scoring 13 points on 5-of-9 shooting.
- •La Salle drained 11 three-pointers and shot nearly 50 percent from deep (11-24, 45.8%).
- •Freshman Ed Croswell paced the team with nine rebounds while classmate Jared Kimbrough added seven. The duo combined for nine offensive boards.
- Junior Traci Carter dished out a season-high six assists and hit his average with three steals.
- •The inside trio of Croswell, Kimbrough and sophomore Miles Brookins went a combined 8-for-9 from the field and totaled 19 points and 18 rebounds.

ABOUT THE WOODEN LEGACY

- •The Wooden Legacy was formed in June 2013 when the John R. Wooden Classic was merged with the Anaheim Classic, which was an eight-school bracketed event played for six years (2007-2012) at the Anaheim Convention Center.
- •Nine of the 11 Anaheim Classic/Wooden Legacy winners have gone on to earn NCAA Tournament bids, with West Virginia advancing to the 2010 Final Four.
- With the exception of Miami (Fla.), the other seven schools will be competing in their first Wooden Legacy event.
- •Miami won its last two games in the 2013 Wooden Legacy after losing their opening contest in overtime.
- •Grand Canyon, Miami, Seton Hall and Utah competed in the 2018 postseason, with Miami and Seton Hall earning bids to the NCAA Tournament.
- •The Utes were selected to compete in the 2018 National Invitation Tournament, while Grand Canyon participated in the College Insider Tournament.

POST-GAME INTERVIEWS

La Salle head coach Ashley Howard and selected players will be available in the Media Room after a 10-minute cooling off period. Visiting coaches and players will be available in the Media Room on a game-by-game basis. Order of coaches appearance in post-game interview to be determined on a per-game basis. La Salle's locker room is closed to the media.

EXPLORING THE WEST COAST

- •La Salle will be making its first appearance in the Pacific time zone since its magical run to the 2013 Sweet Sixteen.
- •The Explorers squared off against Wichita State in Anaheim, Calif., at Staples Center in the NCAA Tournament on March 28, 2013.
- •The Shockers jumped out to a 16-point halftime lead and defeated La Salle, 72-58.
- •The last regular season game that La Salle played out west came on Dec. 21, 2002 at the University of Southern California (L, 89-63).
- •Altogether, La Salle is 12-20 in the Pacific Time Zone, 4-2 in Hawaii and 2-0 in Tokyo, Japan.

A NEW ERA BEGINS!

- •Philadelphia native Ashley Howard became the 14th head coach in La Salle University men's basketball history in April.
- •Howard, who most recently served as the top assistant for head coach Jay Wright and the defending national champion Villanova, spent four years as an assistant with the Explorers from 2004-08.
- •A Drexel University alum, he also spent time on Chris Mack's staff at Xavier and under Bruiser Flint as his alma mater.
- •Howard is the son of Maurice Howard, a standout player at Maryland and a second-round selection in the 1976 NBA Draft of the Cleveland Cavaliers.

POOKIE PUSHES PAST 1,000

- Graduate student Pookie Powell eclipsed the 1,000-point plateau for his collegiate career in La Salle's game against Florida on Nov. 14.
- Powell's first free throw made in the closing seconds of the first half put him at the milestone
- •For his La Salle career, Powell is just 83 points shy of hitting the mark and would become the 57th player in school history to accomplish the feat.
- •On the year, Powell leads the Explorers and ranks in the top five among individuals in the Atlantic 10 in scoring at 20.5 points per game.
- Powell also has a streak of 10 straight games, dating back to last year, that he has scored 10 points or more.

BEATTY. POWELL GRANTED WAIVERS FROM NGAA

- •A pair of Explorers received good news prior to the season started.
- •Powell was granted a sixth year of eligibility by the NCAA in August.
- •The second-leading scorer on La Salle last year, the 6-0 guard averaged 16.9 points per game and was named Second Team Preseason All-Atlantic 10 in October.
- •The good news kept coming in September, when sophomore David Beatty also received permission from the NCAA to compete in 2018-19.
- •Beatty, a Philadelphia native, played last season at the University of South Carolina in the Southeastern Conference.
- •A former four-star recruit out of Imhotep Charter, the athletic 6-3 player will bring a defensive presence and athleticism to the backcourt.
- •Beatty has averaged 12.0 points per game over his last two outings, including a 13-point, 5-for-8 performance at Florida on Nov. 14.

FINDING CONSISTENCY FOR ISIAH

- Junior Isiah Deas has shown signs over the course of his two-year career of being an impact player for the Explorers.
- •In the first game of his collegiate career at Temple as a freshman, Deas made a surprise start and scored 12 points in an overtime loss to the Owls.
- •Last year, the 6-6 guard had 13 games in which he scored 10 or more points, including a 24-point outburst at eventual Patriot League champion Bucknell.
- •He averaged 15.8 points over a seven-game stretch against Atlantic 10 foes in 2017-18, before ending the season with a similar seven-game stretch where he averaged just 4.1 ppg.
- •Deas scored 23 points in the season opener at Temple, but struggled through a 4-of-11 performance at Florida on Wednesday.
- •Coming off the bench in each of the last two games, Deas is averaging 11.5 points per game and overall is shooting a team-best 48.1 percent from three-point range.

FRESHMAN BIGS PRIMED TO CONTRIBUTE

- •La Salle added three freshmen to the mix in 2018-19, including a pair of local big men who are going to play big roles in 2018-19.
- •Ed Croswell is a 6-8 forward who played under legendary head coach and La Salle Hall of Athletes member Speedy Morris at St. Joe's Prep.
- •Croswell tallied five points and four rebounds vs. Florida on Nov. 14.
- •Another freshman forward, Jared Kimbrough, hails from Neptune, N.J.
- •Also standing at 6-8, Kimbrough has the ability to score both inside and out, and has a tremendous upside with his athleticism.
- •Kimbrough led La Salle in rebounding in the first three games of the season and is currently tied for sixth among Atlantic 10 players in offensive rebounding (3.0/game).

CARTER SET TO LEAD LA SALLE IN 2018-19

- Redshirt junior Traci Carter was forced to sit out last season due to NCAA transfer rules, after coming to La Salle following two seasons at Marquette.
- •The 6-1 Philly native is primed to lead the Explorers from the point guard position this year.
- •One of the top distributors in the BIG EAST as a freshman for the Golden Eagles, Carter averaged 4.6 assists per game to lead the team and rank fifth in the league.
- •He was also tied for fifth in the conference in steals per game at 1.5.
- •Through four games, he is tied for eighth in the Atlantic 10 in assists (3.5/game) and tied for the conference lead in steals (3.0/game).

BROOKINS LOOKS FOR BREAKOUT SEASON

- •Sophomore big man Miles Brookins was a pleasant surprise for the Explorers in 2017-18, and will look to build upon a solid rookie season.
- •Brookins converted nearly 60 percent of his field goal attempts (59.7%) while averaging 3.8 points over 29 contests.
- •The 6-10 forward/center scored a career-high 13 points against nationally-ranked Rhode Island and had 11 at George Washington.
- •Brookins matched his career high with 13 points against Lafayette and pulled down six rebounds in 29 minutes.
- •The California native, who is near the top of the A-10 in FG% (63.2%), also hit the first three-pointer of his collegiate career vs. Lafayette.

COMPETITIVE SCHEDULE IN 2018-19

- •As is the case year in and year out, La Salle will face an extremely competitive non-conference schedule this season.
- •The Explorers will face Big 5 foes Villanova, Penn and Temple, with Villanova and Penn having advanced to last season's NCAA Tournament and the Wildcats winning the title.
- •A trip to the University of Florida just passed, with another opportunity to face quality competition coming up in California.
- •La Salle will face Miami (Fla.) in the opening round of the Wooden Legacy on Thanksgiving Day, and will square off against either Northwestern or Fresno State in the second game.
- •Additional matchups with regional foes Drexel, Lafayette and Bucknell dot the schedule, as does a trip to Atlantic City for a tournament that features Tulane, Towson and Alabama A&M.

MOSELY ENTERS FOLD AS GRADUATE TRANSFER

- •Graduate transfer Cheddi Mosely was the final piece of the puzzle for head coach Ashley Howard's 2018-19 roster.
- •Mosely enrolled at La Salle for the fall semester after completing graduate requirements at Boston University, where he was a four-year letterwinner on the men's basketball team.
- •The 6-3 guard led the Terriers in scoring as a sophomore, ranking near the top of the league in scoring, three-point percentage and steals.
- •Mosely hit a pair of three-pointers in the home opener against Lafayette and had a La Salle high 13 points vs. Drexel on Nov. 17.

HOWARD ASSEMBLES QUALITY STAFF

- •In his first order of business as new head coach, Ashley Howard announced that former La Salle standout and Big 5 Hall of Famer Donnie Carr would remain on staff as an assistant coach.
- Joining Carr are fellow assistants Kyle Griffin, who was recruited by Howard to La Salle during his stint on Dr. John Giannini's staff, and former Indiana assistant Kenny Johnson.
- •Former NBA player and First Team All-Atlantic Coast Conference honoree Sean Singletary was added as a graduate assistant.
- •Rounding out the other staff positions are two more holdovers from the previous staff, special assistant to the head coach Horace "Pappy" Owens and director of basketball operations Andrew McGlynn, as well as video coordinator Patrick Reilingh.

WAITING IN THE WINGS

- •Along with transfers David Beatty and Cheddi Mosely, who will be eligible to play in 2018-19, La Salle added a third transfer in 6-6 wing Scott Spencer.
- •Spencer played two seasons at Clemson, where he battled injuries for much of the time.
- •An elite shooter during high school days, Spencer closed his career at Blue Ridge as the school's all-time three-point field goals made leader despite playing just two seasons at the school.
- •Spencer will sit out the 2018-19 season due to NCAA transfer rules and will be eligible in 2019-20.

RECENT ALUMS SIGN PRO DEALS

- •Two members of the La Salle men's basketball Class of 2018 signed contracts to play professional basketball.
- •B.J. Johnson, who led the Explorers in scoring for two straight seasons and was a two-time First Team All-Big 5 selection, is currently playing with the Orlando Magic's G-League affiliate in Lakeland.
- •Through five games, he is averaging 8.2 points and 4.4 rebounds per game.
- •Johnson's frontcourt teammate, Tony Washington, signed with a top division team in the Netherlands.
- •The duo joins a group of former Explorers playing basketball at the professional level that includes Ramon Galloway, Steve Zack and Tyreek Duren.

ASHLEY HOWARD

Head Coach Drexel '04 First Season

Ashley Howard was named the 19th head coach of the storied men's basketball program at La Salle University on April 8, 2018. Howard most recently served as the top assistant coach to Jay Wright at Villanova University for five seasons.

"As a former assistant coach at La Salle, we know firsthand that Ashley Howard is an exceptional coaching talent who has a deep understanding of both La Salle's basketball tradition and its important student-focused mission," said Bill Bradshaw, Director of Intercollegiate Athletics and Recreation for La Salle University. "This is a university that holds character, integrity and commitment to that mission in the highest esteem, and our men's

basketball coach has the unique responsibility of reflecting that on and off the court."

"We have every confidence that Ash will do that – and more – in leading this program," Bradshaw continued. "He is a high-energy leader with a tremendous basketball pedigree as well as a strong track record of recruiting, developing and mentoring high-quality student-athletes. His experience, especially in the past five years, reflects that Ash knows how to win. We are delighted to welcome him home to La Salle University."

Howard accepted the new role after five seasons as the top assistant coach to Jay Wright at Villanova University. During his tenure there, Howard was involved in all aspects of the Villanova program including on-court teaching, player development and recruiting. He was instrumental in helping the Wildcats win two NCAA National Championships and setting a new NCAA record for the most wins in a four-year span.

Prior to Villanova, Howard earned a decade's worth of college coaching experience. He began his career as a student assistant coach at his alma mater, Drexel University, in 2002 after injury cut short his playing career for the Dragons.

In 2004, Howard was hired as an assistant to head coach John Giannini at La Salle University. He spent four years with the Explorers before returning to Drexel in 2008 as an assistant coach to James "Bruiser" Flint. He was part of a staff that led the Dragons to consecutive 20-win seasons, including a school record 29 victories in 2011-12.

As a player, Howard was a guard for the Dragons from 1999-2002. In what would turn out to be his last season, Howard averaged 8.9 points and a team-high 4.9 assists per game.

"It's an honor and a privilege to be named the head coach at La Salle University," said Howard. "I chose to coach at La Salle early in my career because of its incredible tradition in the Big 5, its dedication to athletic excellence and its commitment to its student-athletes."

"To have the opportunity to return to campus and lead this storied basketball program – a program defined by greats such as Gola, Durrett, Brooks, Simmons and Butler – is one for which I'm deeply appreciative," Howard said. "I want to thank Athletic Director Bill Bradshaw and President Colleen Hanycz for asking me to lead one of the truly great college basketball programs in the country. I also want to thank all of my coaching mentors, Jay Wright, Chris Mack, Dr. John Giannini and Bruiser Flint, from all of whom I have learned so much about myself, as a coach, and more importantly, as a man. I am ready to seize this moment because of what I learned from each one of them."

Howard, who graduated from Drexel in 2004 with a degree in Communications, is the son of Maurice Howard and Diane Coleman. Maurice Howard played college basketball at the University of Maryland and was a second round draft choice of the NBA's Cleveland Cavaliers.

Before that he starred at Monsignor Bonner High School in Lansdowne, Delaware County where he still holds the single-game scoring record. He is married to Ariana Casanovas and has a daughter, Journey, and a newborn son, Ace.




