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## **Executive Functions: What's the Big Idea?**

EF skills are a group of brain-based abilities that help students “execute” a task from start to finish and self-regulate one’s behavior. Similar to other academic and learning skills, some students may need varying levels of support and intervention. Strategies for teaching and reinforcing specific EF skills will be shared.*
