House Rules, Effective June 2018

Raffle tickets cost \$10 each and are on sale in the Chamber office as of June 11, 2018. Tickets may also be purchased from Chamber volunteers at the following local establishments in downtown Boyne City: Lynda's Real Estate Service (27 S. Lake Street) and Country Now and Then (211 E. Water Street).

The Annual Duck Race will be conducted as follows, in accordance with the State of Michigan Charitable Gaming Division rules and regulations.

The duck race raffle utilizes flexible plastic ducks to determine the winners. The ducks are dumped into the Boyne River all at once, behind Harbor House Publishers and Country Now and Then on Water Street. The first duck across the finish line is declared the winner. The finish line is located near the boardwalk across the river from the Eagles parking lot and across the alley from Lynda's Real Estate.

The ducks will be dumped into the river around 2:30pm on the 4th of July, 2018. The start time of the race is approximate and depends on when the river is cleared of debris and people after the Commemorative Raft Race ends. The race will begin as close to 2:30pm as possible.

Ducks will float downstream into the finish line chute, which will collect the top 10 ducks as winners for cash prizes. Winners will be chosen as follows:

The first duck that floats into the chute will be the grand prize winner of \$1,000.

The second duck into the chute will be the second prize winner of \$250.

The third duck into the chute will be the third prize winner of \$100.

The 4th through 10th ducks into the chute will each win \$50.

Winning duck NUMBERS will be announced about 5 minutes after completion of the race, by the Chamber's DJ, on the boardwalk by the river. Winners' NAMES will be posted on the Chamber office door (28 S. Lake Street) about a half hour after completion of the duck race.

Winners need not be present to win and will be contacted by Chamber staff by 5pm on the day of the raffle drawing, this year July 4, 2018.

Winners who are not present at the time of the drawing may pick up their prize at the Chamber office any time after the raffle. If desired by the winner or to expedite closing of the raffle, Chamber staff may mail a check to the winner if a pick-up time cannot be arranged.

In case of inclement weather or other circumstances which prevent the duck race from being conducted, the winner shall be determined by a traditional raffle drawing on the 4th of July at 2:30pm.

This traditional raffle drawing will be conducted in the Chamber building located at 28 S. Lake Street.

No refunds will be given for purchased raffle tickets.
