



MLK Commemoration Pilgrimage | April 2 - 5, 2018 | Memphis, TN

April 4, 2018 marks the 50th commemoration of the assassination of the Rev. Dr. Martin Luther King, Jr. The Power and Race Team (PART) is planning a four day intergenerational pilgrimage to Memphis to participate in this national remembrance.

Along with members from All Souls Cathedral and Memphis Youth Mission (MYM), GCPC members will spend time building community while learning about the past, present, and future of the Civil Rights Movement. The trip will be Monday, April 2 – Thursday, April 5. The cost payable to GCPC will vary from \$300 - \$700 per person, depending on food, lodging, and activity choices. There may be additional food and travel costs not included in this amount.

Details and Options

Travel via 15-passenger vans will be covered by GCPC.

Option 1 - Lodging and Programming at [Memphis Youth Mission](#) (MYM) - \$300

This price includes:

- accomodations in downtown Memphis
 - ◆ indoor camping style with air mattresses and floor space
 - ◆ showers are available but not on site
- 3 meals Tuesday and Wednesday and 2 meals Thursday,
- daily learning/work sites with local Memphis organizations,
- daily Civil Rights Movement historical sites and free remembrance events
- nightly de-briefing with MYM staff

Option 2 - Lodging at [Comfort Inn](#) sharing a room with one person - \$475

This price includes:

- hotel accomodations .28 miles from the MYM site in downtown Memphis
 - ◆ two queen beds; hot breakfast included
- 3 meals Tuesday and Wednesday and 2 meals Thursday,
- daily learning/work sites with local Memphis organizations,
- daily Civil Rights Movement historical sites and free remembrance events
- nightly de-briefing with MYM staff

Option 3 - Lodging at Comfort Inn sharing a room with 3 people - \$360

This price includes everything in Option 2. Four people would share the hotel room.

Option 4 - Lodging at Comfort Inn with a single room - \$675

This price includes everything in Option 2.
