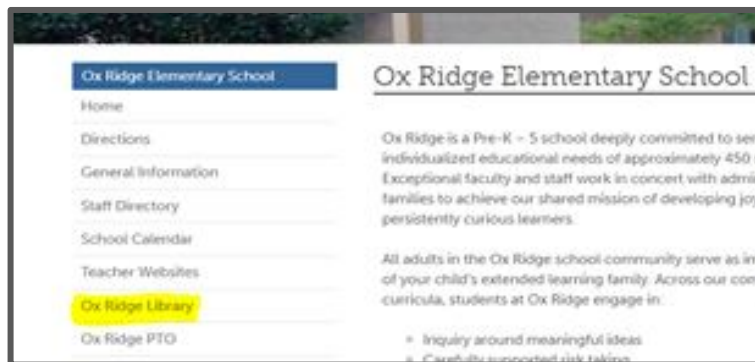




# Ox Ridge Now Has OverDrive!

## How to Access eBooks and audiobooks using Ox Ridge's Overdrive Collection

1. Visit the Ox Ridge Library Learning Commons Google Site at <https://sites.google.com/darienps.org/ox-ridge-learning-commons>
2. Click on the link for OverDrive Audio and ebooks and then click the link to get to the OverDrive login page.
3. In the sign in page, enter student's information.

**Username** = Student's Chromebook/Google login WITHOUT @darienps.org

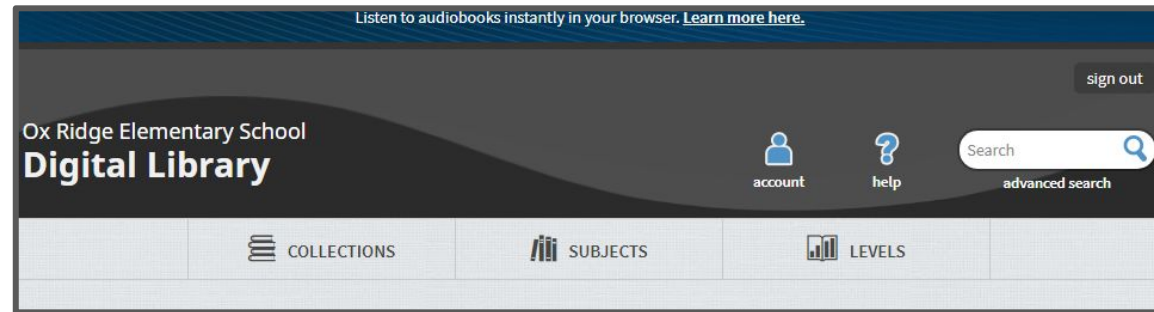

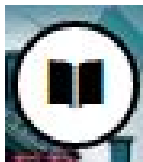

 Gray = you can place it on hold

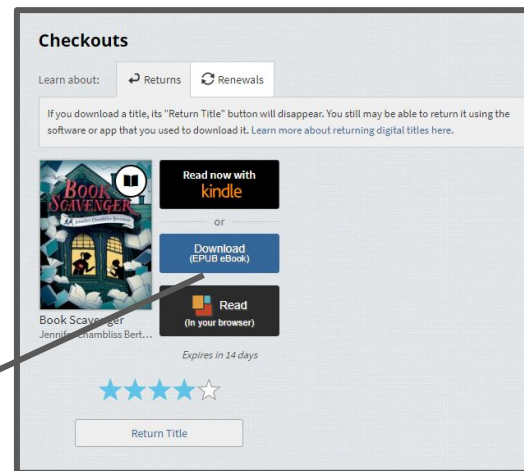



6. When your cursor/arrow hovers over the book cover, you can

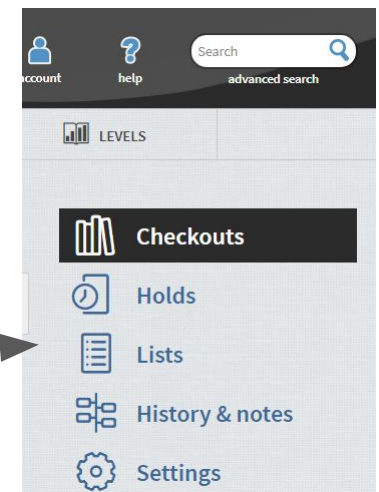
- Borrow/Place a Hold

## Getting started with the OverDrive app

You can use the free OverDrive app (available in all major app stores) to borrow and download digital books from your school.

### Step 1

Install the OverDrive app from your device's app store or from [app.overdrive.com](http://app.overdrive.com).

### Step 2

In the app, select **Sign up** and create an OverDrive account. This is different than your student ID or school login. Or, if you're under 13 or don't want an OverDrive account\*, select the **Under 13 years old or using OverDrive through your school?** link.

\*An OverDrive account enables you to download and sync EPUB eBooks on multiple devices.

### Step 3

Find and save your school in the OverDrive app.

### Step 4

Tap on your school's name to open its OverDrive collection, sign in using your student ID or school login, and borrow a book.

### Step 5

Borrowed books appear on your **Checkouts** page (under your **Account**). From there, select **Download** or **Add to app** to download the book to your app bookshelf.

### About the OverDrive app

The latest version of the OverDrive app is available for Android, Chromebooks, iOS (iPhone, iPad, iPod touch), Kindle Fire tablets, Kobo tablets, NOOK tablets, and Windows 8 and up.
