Shot Clinic Hours

- Tuesday, Wednesday, and Thursday mornings 8:00 AM – 9:00 AM
- Wednesday 1:00 PM – 3:00 PM
- Second and Fourth Thursday 4:30 PM – 6:45 PM

Vaccines are given on a “first come first serve basis”.

No Appointment is needed but **MUST BRING** vaccine record, insurance card and photo ID of parent or legal guardian.

Consent forms must be completed by parent or legal guardian.

Co-pays are expected at the time of visit. We accept all major credit cards/debit cards, cash or checks.

Hardship waiver is available for those who cannot afford to pay childhood vaccines.

NO CHILD IS TURNED AWAY IF UNABLE TO PAY FOR VACCINES.

Clinic Immunization Protocol

2 months: DTaP, Hep B, Polio, Hib, Prevnar, RotaTeq	*Yearly: Influenza (after 6 months of age)
4 months: DTaP, *Hep B, Hib, Polio, Prevnar, RotaTeq	*Hep B at 4 months not given if infant received 1 st dose at birth
6 months: DTaP, Hep B, Hib, Polio, Prevnar, RotaTeq	*Every 10 years: Td or Tdap
12-15 months: DTaP, Hib, Prevnar, MMR/Varicella, Hep A	
18 months: Hep A	
4-6 years: DTaP, Polio, MMR/Varicella	
11-12 years: Tdap, *Menactra, HPV	*Trumenba offered for serogroup B meningococcal disease
Grade 12: Menactra
