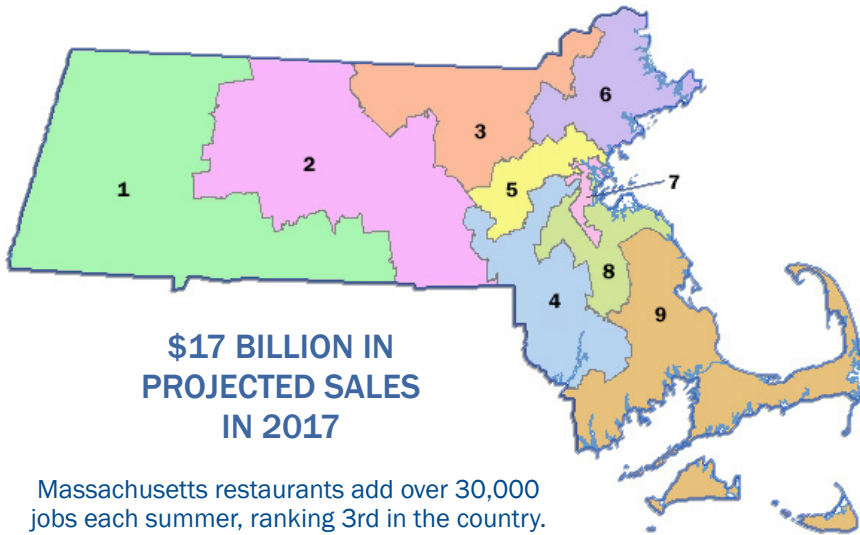

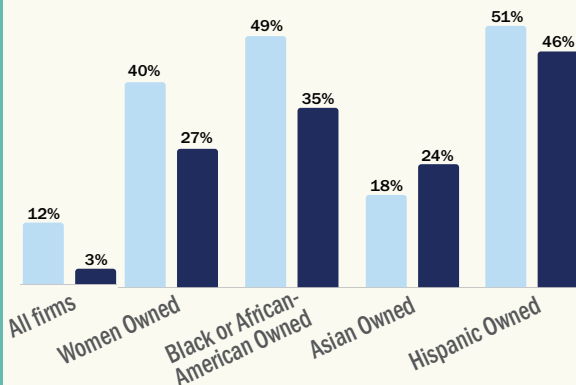

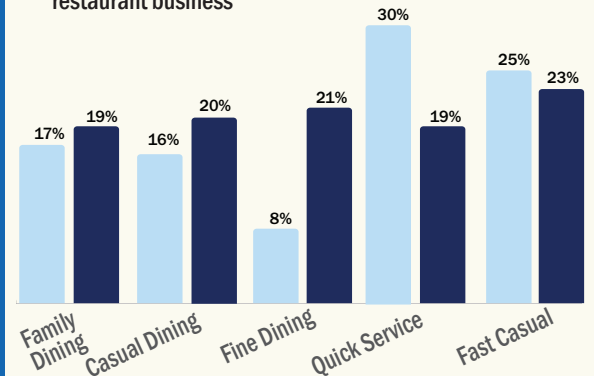
### PROPORTION OF BUSINESSES THAT ARE MAJORITY-OWNED BY MINORITIES
