*The bus picks the children at H.A. Jones up at approx. 3:05pm, then picks up from Bremen Academy at approx. 3:25pm. PK/1st graders wanting to be picked up by the bus will need to enroll/pay for the After-School Program at H.A. Jones. School/ASP personnel will walk them to the bus location at 3pm and they will need to be registered for the after school program unless they will be dropped off at the church by a parent or guardian.

We allow time for snack/fellowship before we begin our rotations. We have 3 rotations that begin at 3:45 separated by age groups. The groups are: Music, Missions, & a Message. Music will be where the children learn their songs for choir that they will perform 2 times a year at church services.

KID QUEST is a children's Bible-study program on Wednesday afternoons offered by the First United Methodist Church of Bremen. This program is an active, Bible-based study which will not only teach children about God, but also how to share God's Word and Love with others, and encourage them to live according to God's plan daily. We partake in weekly mission projects to teach children the importance of giving back to our community and shining your light to others for Jesus.
