### National Endowment for the Humanities Summer Stipends

#### Deadlines

**Internal deadline: July 26, 2018**

**Agency deadline: September 26, 2018**

**Limit: 2**

National Endowment for the Humanities Summer Stipends support individuals pursuing advanced research that is of value to humanities scholars, general audiences, or both. Eligible projects usually result in articles, monographs, books, digital materials and publications, archaeological site reports, translations, or editions. Projects must not result solely in the collection of data; instead they must also incorporate analysis and interpretation. Summer Stipends support continuous full-time work on a humanities project for a period of two consecutive months.

If interested, submit an internal application (or “pre-proposal”) to the Office of Research Development [here](#) no later than **July 26**. The required documents for the internal application can be found [here](#). If the Division receives more internal applications than the allowed limits, an ad hoc review and selection process will be held. If an ad hoc review process is not warranted, those researchers that demonstrated interest will be allowed to move forward with submitting a full proposal to the funding agency.
