

OnPAR | Online Partnership to Accelerate

The goal of OnPAR is to give a second funding opportunity to highly scored, unfunded applications from NIH, NSF, FDA, CDC, DOE, NASA and other funding agencies. Managed by health contractor Leidos in partnership with NIH, there's no cost for investigators to submit their materials.

Current potential funders include the Breast Cancer Research Foundation, Cure Alzheimer's Fund, Epilepsy Foundation, JDRF, Bill & Melinda Gates Foundation, Rockefeller Foundation, NSF, NASA, DOE, FOA, among others.

Registration is via a ten-minute form, according to OnPAR.

Application Process

- 1.) **Basic Registration:** Click [here](#).
- 2.) **Submission of Public Abstract:** This is the public abstract that is submitted with the original funding application.
- 3.) **Submission of Applications, Peer-Review and NDA:** If there is a match, then OnPAR requests the full application, the peer-review received from the original funding agency and a signed non-disclosure agreement provided by OnPAR. OnPAR does not require investigators to re-write the unfunded application.

After funders renew submitted materials, investigators will be contacted directly to discuss potential partnerships and funding.

It is free for all investigators to submit their materials.
